

The National Lottery Supports Young People in High Wycombe with Cost-of-Living Fund

The National Lottery has awarded a Community Cost of Living grant of £75k to support Action4Youth's High Wycombe Youth Centre, The Junction.

Funding from the Lottery Cost of Living Fund will support vital work at The Junction during a time when many young people cannot afford or gain access to necessary support or recreational activities.

The Junction supports over 2000 young people living in and around High Wycombe every year and is open every day providing a warm safe space for young people with services such as mentoring, Counselling, crisis support, homework clubs, and cooking sessions.

With the funding from The National Lottery fund together, we're not just helping to alleviate financial burdens; we're investing in the future of local young people and the next generation."

The funding will mean that The Junction can support and reach more young people from in and around High Wycombe and offer vital support, especially during the cost-of-living crisis.
